February 17, 1927 - August 20, 2020

THOMAS CHARLES MILLER, 93, of Emlenton passed away Thursday morning (08-20-20) at the residence of his caregiver and daughter Mitzi Marano with whom he had resided the past four years.

Tom was born in Fairview, Butler County on February 17, 1927, to the late Lawrence and Esther Cumberland Miller.

He was married to the former Louise Jackson on May 20, 1948, and she preceded him in death on October 7, 2014.

Tom was a longtime member of Foxburg United Methodist Church.

He served in Germany during World War II as a guard patrolman with the U.S. Army. Prior to the military and afterward, he worked at former RexHide in East Brady. He then sold automobiles for the late Emil Long, Sr.(and Long Motors), and then worked as a sales rep. for Conway McCulloch in lawn and garden sales for forty-six years. Following retirement, he was employed part-time for Allegheny Township (Butler Co.) and assisted his father-in-law for many years with the Jackson family farm.

He lived and loved life to the fullest extent, and touched so many lives with that creed. He believed in honesty, hard work, and providing for his family.
