On May 14, 2024, Alice Pihoker, daughter of Alice Ann (Koslosky) Pihoker and the late Francis J Pihoker, passed away peacefully at the age of 66. Born August 9, 1957, she grew up in Coopersburg, Pennsylvania, attended school at Southern Lehigh in Center Valley, Pennsylvania, and went on to earn a degree in communications at Duquesne University.

Alice worked for a number of radio stations throughout her career - including WAMO Radio, WDVE, and C93. She also acted as a disk jockey and concert security for DiCesare Engler Productions. Alice was an avid quilter. She gave back to her community through volunteering at the Foxburg Free Library. Alice was known by many through her work at Central Electric Co-Operative and later through her dispatch work for Gardenscape. Alice was a devoted member of St Michael the Archangel Roman Catholic Church of Emlenton.
