AVANEIL JEAN POLLOCK, 81, of Parker passed away late Thursday evening (05-14-20) at Good Samaritan Hospice in Cabot, Pa. following a period of declining health.

Born in Porter Twp., Clarion Co. on October 27, 1938, she was daughter of late Arthur Glenn and Bernice Pence Henry.
