BERTHA E. "Betty" McHENRY, 90, of Parker passed away at 5:10 AM Wednesday morning (06-05-13) at Clarview Nursing and Rehabilitation Center, Sligo following a brief illness. Born in Foxburg on September 21, 1922, she was daughter of the late Wesley Harris and Mary Elizabeth Bashline McHenry.
