CHARLES R. "CHUCK" BEER, 78, of Parker passed away on Thursday, June 14, at Butler Memorial Hospital.

Born in Parker on June 2, 1940, he was the son of the late Robert "Rudy" Rudolph and H. Virginia "Ginny" Gibson Beer.

Chuck was a 1958 graduate of the former Parker High School. Shortly following graduation, Chuck enlisted in the United States Army serving in Germany. He was United Methodist by faith. In December of 1963, he married the late Suzanne C. Fox Beer, whom passed May 12, 2018. They shared 55 years of marriage.

Chuck was a retired tank inspector from the former Witco Chemical Corporation (Sonneborn) at Petrolia. He was a long-time member serving over 50 years with the Parker City Volunteer Fire Department serving as assistant chief, driving truck, and dispatcher. Chuck was also a member of the American Legion Post 598 of Parker.
