David Lee Addleman, 81, of Cabot, PA., went home to be with the Lord on June 9th, 2016 after a brief illness at the Good Samaritan Hospice in Cabot. Born March 18, 1935 in Mount Pleasant, PA., he was the son of the late Charles W. and Esther L. (Keating) Addleman.

He was a 1954 graduate of Emlenton High School. On July 2, 1955, he married the former Joann McNany of Emlenton. He lived for many years in Scrubgrass Township, Emlenton, and later in Franklin before moving to Cabot.

A 20 year veteran of the United States Navy, he retired as a Master Chief Operations Specialist with the grade of E-9.
