DAVID A. TERWILLIGER, 66, of Boyers went to be with his Lord and Saviour Thursday evening (01-16-14) at his residence surrounded by his loving family. His passing was following a courageous battle with cancer. Born in Butler County on March 12, 1947, he was the adopted son of the late Harry H. and Elmira E. Shawl Terwilliger. It is important to note that David and his brother Larry of Parker, also adopted by the Terwilligers, met and became very close with their eight blood siblings a number of years ago.
