Debbie Barger Jordan Leavy, 68, didn't get to ring the cancer bell, but she rang the bell to heaven on Saturday, May 24. She passed away after a courageous battle with cancer at her home with her family by her side. She was born in Butler on March 31, 1957, and was the daughter of the late Charles D. and Shirley A.
