DELYTE F. GRIMM MURRAY, 67, of Butler, formerly of Parker, passed early Saturday morning at her residence in Butler following an illness.

Born in Venango Co., Pa. on August 4th 1951, daughter of late Halbert R and Betty Faye King Grimm.

Following graduation from Allegheny-Clarion Valley School in 1969, she earned a degree as a Registered Nurse. She practiced a career in nursing much of her adult life.

She was a dedicated member of the Church of Jesus Christ of the Latter Day Saints.

She was married March 24th 1973 to the late John Ross Murray, and their marriage was sealed for eternity at the Washington D.C. Temple of the Church on April 15, 1978. John died October 24th, 2009.

Delyte's accomplishments in life was in her name: she was an absolute delight with her smile, caring, and loving presence.
