DeWayne L. DeLoe, 68, of Route 58, Sligo (Callensburg area) passed away at 3:00 AM Monday morning (01-14-13) at his residence following an extended illness. Born in Turkey City, Clarion County on May 20, 1944, he was the son of the late Newton E. and Evelyn Dittman DeLoe. DeWayne graduated from Allegheny-Clarion Valley School at Emlenton in 1962. He served with distinction in U.S. Army in the early sixties being honorably discharged with the rank of SP/4. While serving in Viet Nam, he earned six Air Medals, each with the Oak Leaf Cluster as well as two Purple Hearts. He earned several other military medals as well. Over the years he worked with Quaker State Refining in Emlenton, and with SMI Structural Modular Homes and Castle Homes, both of Clarion County. Mr. DeLoe was Protestant by faith. Surviving are his wife, Robin Matson Heeter DeLoe whom he married August 2, 1997; one son and wife, Rodney (Rod) and Cheryl DeLoe of Moon Twp., Allegheny Co., and two step-sons: Jason (Christina) Heeter and Michael (Misty) Heeter, both of Callensburg; two grandchildren and three step-grandchildren; four sisters: Helen Bowman of South Carolina, Pauline Wyncoop of Madison, OH, Elizabeth Watson of New York, and Delores Adamson of Erie; two brothers: Charles DeLoe of Pittsburgh and John (Nancy) DeLoe of McKean (Erie Co.), and a number of nieces and nephews.
