Edward Paul Pago Sr., 90, passed away on December 12, 2024, and went home to be with his Lord. He was also an outdoor enthusiast, enjoying activities such as fishing, hunting, canoeing, and hiking. Additionally, he loved traveling, was an avid reader, and enjoyed watching classic movies.

He was a former member of the VFW, American Legion, and Moose Lodge. He was honorably discharged from the U.S. Army and remained in the Army Reserves for several years after his discharge.

He was married to Patricia Beckwith Pago, who preceded him in death. He was also preceded by his parents and four sisters. He had two children from his first wife, Ellen Yates Pago Sullivan: Deborah Dunkle and her husband William of Harrisville, PA, and
