



## Fred Terwilliger Sr.

July 2, 1932 - October 14, 2015

Fred Terwilliger Sr., 83, of Parker, PA., passed away Wednesday evening at his residence after a long illness. Born in West Freedom outside of Parker, PA., on July 2nd 1932, he was the son of the late Donald Tilton and Hazel I. Wilson Terwilliger. Fred attended the Former Parker High School and later joined the United States Army where he was a medic in the MASH Unit during the Korean War. He has been married for 57 years to Ruthann Virginia Connor who survives. Fred worked at the former Koppers Chemical in Petrolia for 35 years before retiring in 1995.
