September 9, 1931 - September 26, 2019

H. Louise Rupert, 88, of Clarion, Pa., formerly of West Freedom passed to Paradise at 4:00 AM Thursday (09-26-19) morning at Clarview Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Sligo following a brief illness.

Born in Wayne Twp., Dayton, Pa. on Sept. 9, 1931, she was daughter of late Ralph and Mary Bargerstock Rumbaugh.

Louise graduated from Dayton High School, and became a registered nurse. She was a sixty plus year member of West Freedom United Methodist Church and served in many capacities in the church. She was also life member and past worthy matron of OES Chapter 60 of Parker. Retiring from nursing in 1970, she became a member of the "Nuttly Knitters" group that gathered to knit, eat, and share recipes.

While working as an emergency room nurse, she met patient Meredith Rupert who would become her husband on Dec. 30, 1953. Meredith passed away Oct. 18, 2011.

Louise lived much of her life in West Freedom, and moved to Water Run Living Center three years ago. Following her recent strokes, she was being cared for by staff at Clarview.

Louise is survived by two sons, Samuel E. (Joyce) Rupert, of Parker and Randall E. Rupert of Clarion. Step grand kids, Cindy (Scott) King, of Parker, and Timothy (Deb) Shook, of Butler. Step great grandchildren, Justin (Kylee) Shook, Keighlene (Tom) Linamen, Keaton King and great great

granddaughter, Teagan Jade Shook born 9/24/2019.

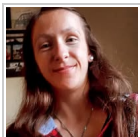

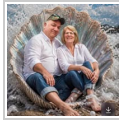
