



## Harry John Armstrong

June 5, 1921 - May 15, 2014

HARRY JOHN ARMSTRONG, 92, of Ohio, formerly of Parker, Pa. passed away Thursday, May 15, 2014 at residence of his son Jeff, of natural causes. Born in Parker on June 5, 1921, he was the son of the late Harry J. and Ethel Hallack Armstrong. A 1939 graduate of the former Parker high School, he served in World War II from Jan. 1941 to October 1945. Much of his war experience was a radio repair and operator at a weather station in the Baffin Islands. He was honorably discharged with the rank of Tech. Sgt. He was a charter member of Roy Calvin McGinnis VFW Post 7073 of Parker. He retired from the former Pullman Standard of Butler where he was foreman of the carpenter shop. He also owned and operated Armstrong's TV and Radio Shop in Parker. He is survived by his son Jeff and wife of Ohio, two step-sons, and three sisters: Eva Mae Huemrich, June Gardner, and Mary "Mare" McCoy. In addition to parents, he was preceded in death by a sister, Betty West, late of Parker. All arrangements and services were private at the request of the deceased.
