JOHN E. BOWSER, 84, of Licking Twp., Parker, Pa. passed away Saturday evening (07-23-16) at his residence following a period of declining health. Born in West Monterey, Pa. on May 6, 1932, he was son of late Lawrence L. and Vera Everetts Bowser. John served in the early fifties with the U.S. Army being honorably discharged with rank of corporal. He earned the occupation of Germany medal and the NDSM.
