John Kevin Krainz, 65, of Coraopolis, formerly of Emlenton, passed away after a year-long battle with Leukemia early Sunday morning at the West Penn Hospital. Born in Pittsburgh on October 18, 1957, he was the son of the late Richard Krainz and Marianne O'Shanka Krainz who survives.

John was a graduate of the Allegheny Clarion Valley High School before serving in the U.S. Army. His appreciation for Veterans never left his mind.
