JOSEPH H. "Joe" McCALL, 79, of Perry Twp., Parker, Pa. passed away mid-afternoon Thursday (04-05-12) of natural causes en route to his home following discharge from UPMC-Seneca. Born in Perry Twp., Clarion Co. on Feb. 15, 1933, he was the son of the late Byron F. and Mary K. Heeter McCall. Joe was a 1951 graduate of the former Parker High School, and he served with the U. S.
