LEWIS RAY PEOPLES, 66, of Slippery Rock, Pa. passed away Sunday evening at Butler Memorial Hospital following an illness. Born on Nov. 3, 1945 in Butler, he was son of late James A. and Martha Grace Logue Peoples. Lewis was Catholic by faith.
