MARCIA E. KING FULMER, 83, of West Freedom, Parker, Pa. passed away Wednesday evening (10-02-19) at her residence surrounded by her loving family following a period of declining health.

Born in Butler, Pa. on June 4, 1936, she was the daughter of late Harry and Helen Bartoe King.

She was a 1955 graduate of the former Parker High School, and was Protestant by faith.
