Max R. Conner, Miami, Florida, passed away peacefully in the comfort of his home on Thursday morning, April 2, 2026. He was nearly 88.

for a few years before finally settling into an apartment home in Miami, FL.

He was preceded in death by his daughter Tammy in 1999. He is survived by his
