MAXINE GRACE McCALL, 84, of The Caring Place, Franklin, Pa., formerly of Emlenton passed away Saturday evening (03-09-13) at The Caring Place following a period of declining health. Born in Emlenton on Jan. 15, 1929, she was the daughter of the late Thomas L. and Grace E. Weeter Ritchey. Maxine was a graduate of the former Emlenton High School, and the Franklin Commercial College in December of 1947. She was protestant by faith. She was employed by the REA of Parker for a number of years, and then was later the secretary for the Westminster Highlands near Emlenton. Maxine had a unique fondness for nature, especially feeding deer as she lived on her property and studying and caring for birds. She was involved with Project Feeder Watch by the Cornell (Univ.) Lab of Orinithology. She is survived by a daughter: Diane (Michael) Morkin of Franklin and two sons: Donald (Eileen) McCall, Cmdr., USN-Ret. of Virginia Beach, Va. and Larry (Shari) McCall of Eau Claire; five grandchildren and four great-grandchildren; two sisters: Beverly (Robert) Eckelbarger of Emlenton and June Kozikowski of Centerville, MD.; number of nieces and nephews. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Oscar R. McCall whom she married Oct. 8, 1952 and who passed away April 9, 1991.
