Nancy Lee Stowe, 94, of Parker, PA, passed away at the Parker Personal Care Home on Monday, January 15, 2024.

Born on November 24, 1929, in Harrisville, Nancy was the daughter of the late Charles H. Sr. and Lyda Orr Fryman. She attended Grove City High School and later worked in the banking industry before starting her own upholstery business, where she taught the trade for many years.

Nancy was passionate about farming and spent much of her childhood on her family's farm. She continued to farm with her husband, James O. Stowe, whom she married on November 4, 1949. James preceded Nancy in death on November 12, 2010.

Nancy was known for her big heart and her love of animals. She was a foster parent for many years and enjoyed taking care of her dogs, who accompanied her on many four-wheeling adventures. She was also an active member of the Scrubgrass Stone Church and served as a judge on the Allegheny Township Board of Elections for 60 years.
