Patricia J. Hagan, 86, of Parker, PA., passed away early Thursday (Oct 6, 2016) morning at the Butler Memorial Hospital after a brief illness. Patricia was born in Indiana, Pa., on April 27, 1930 to the late William Wesley and Beulah McGaughey Mottern.

She was United Methodist by faith. She married Alby E. Hagan on November 22, 1953 and who preceded her in death on December 26, 2012.
