PAULINE ANNA KRIEBEL SLAUGHENHOUPPT treated everyone she met with kindness and generosity. She died Wednesday, Sept. 28, 2022, at Parker Personal Care Home in Parker, Pa.

Born in Dutch Hill, Pa. on Dec. 15, 1927, the daughter of the late Lindsay Samuel and Orpha May Gallagher Kriebel. She married Gerald “Hap” Slaughenhaupt on Feb. 13, 1947, and he preceded her in death on April 1, 2013, after sixty-six years of marriage.
