



Ralph L. Nail

November 18, 1935 - July 15, 2024

Ralph L. Nail, 88, of Hilliards, PA, passed away peacefully at the Caring Place in Franklin on Monday, July 15, after a period of declining health. Ralph was born in Butler on November 18, 1935, and was the son of the late Ralph F and Ruth Boyle Nail.

Ralph was a member and former Elder at the East Unity Presbyterian Church in Cherry Valley. He started his career as an excavator with Frank Ross Jr., where he worked for many years. Later, he bought the business and excavated for 62 years before retiring to the family farm in 2012. Ralph taught himself through various experiences and became a master mechanic. Ralph was married to Dorothy Clay Nail on July 15, 1957. She passed away on April 25, 2006.

Surviving is his daughter: Patti (Joe) Lowers of Harrisville. Three sons: Robert "Bob" (Drema) Nail of Gulfport, MS; Kenneth Nail of Hilliards; Ronald Nail of Hilliards. One granddaughter: Samantha.
