Raymond Howard Fair, 95 of Greensboro, NC formerly of Dutch Hill, Parker, Pa., went to be with his Lord and Savior on Sunday (8/25/2013) after a short illness. Born on November 29, 1917 in Clarion County, Pa., he was the son of the late Frank and Jennie Conner Fair. Ray was a member of the former Dutch Hill Church of God (now the Park Hill Church of God in West Freedom) where he was a member of the Board of Trustees as well as the Sunday School Superintendent for 13 years.
