Rebecca E. "Becky" Watts, 76, of Hovey Twp., Parker, Pa. passed away Monday (11-04-19) at Butler Memorial Hospital following an illness.

Born in Sewickley, Pa. on May 29, 1943, she was the daughter of the late Lawrence W. and Enid Slagle Black.

She was married to Harry Bartley who passed April of 1981 and later married Irwin James "Jim" Watts who survives.

Becky was a lifelong and active member of Parker United Methodist Church. Graduating from A.C. Valley High School in 1961, she began employment with the former Glass Containers Corp. of Parker. She then was employed later by Rodger's Comet Market (now Welters) of Parker.

She was a member of the former Ladies Auxiliary of both the VFW and American Legion, but the greatest membership she enjoyed was that of the Red Hat (Ladies) Society in which she participated joyfully as long as health permitted.

In addition to her parents and first husband, she was preceded in death by a stepson, Jay Watts, in 2018.
