REGIS L. HUBER, 80, of Parker passed away Sunday evening (03-04-12) of natural causes at the home of his daughter. Born on Oct. 11, 1931 in Pittsburgh, Pa., he was the son of the late Lawrence and Anna Mangold Huber. He was married to the former Lois E. Sattler on Dec. 1, 1958, and she passed away Nov. 24, 2002.
