



## Richard "Dick" A Jackson

May 7, 1941 - June 4, 2011

RICHARD A. "Dick" JACKSON, 70, of Parker, Pa. passed away at 8:30 AM Saturday morning (06-04-11) at Parker Personal Care Home following an illness. Born in Parker on May 7, 1941, he was the son of the late Albert Joseph "Skip" and Marjorie J. Funkhouser Jackson. Dick was a lifelong member of the former St. Mary's Catholic Church at Parker. He was employed by the former Glass Containers Corp. of Parker until his retirement. Most of his employment was in the mold-making department. Mr. Jackson was honorably discharged from the U. S. Army with the rank of SP/4 after serving from 1964 to 1966. He was a veteran of the Viet Nam Conflict. He was the first Viet Nam veteran to join the American Legion of Parker following his service obligation. In addition to the Legion, he was a member of the VFW Post 7073 of Parker. He graduated from Allegheny Clarion Valley School in 1960. Surviving are one sister: Lana (James) Mardis of New Castle and two brothers: William Thomas (Rosalie) of Parker and James A.
