SCOTT T. MARSHALL, 56, of Parker, Pa. passed away Monday afternoon (2-12-18) at Good Samaritan Hospice in Cabot following a brief illness. Born in Butler, Pa., on January 13, 1962, he was the son of Nancy Fisher Marshall and the late John I. Marshall. He was Catholic by faith, and was a 1980 graduate of Allegheny-Clarion Valley School District. He was employed at Shrupp Industries of Parker for over twelve years.
