THOMAS G. "Tom" OCHS, 77, of Greenville, Pa., formerly of West Freedom, passed away early Sunday morning (08-22-21) at his residence following an extended illness and surrounded by his close-knit family.

Born in Petrolia, Pa. on November 6, 1943, he was the son of the late Gerald C. and Claire Colbert Ochs. Tom was reared in the village of West Freedom by his loving grandparents, Maurice and Laura Ochs.

Living in West Freedom, he attended and graduated from Allegheny-Clarion Valley School District. He had resided in Greenville since 1965.
