William Daryl Pollock, 93, of Parker, Pa. passed away Saturday evening following a period of declining health.

Born on December 31, 1930 in Perry Township, Clarion Co., he was the son of the late Merle Alvin and Gay Jordan Pollock.

He was married to the former Avanell Jean Henry on June 18, 1966 and she passed away May 14, 2020.

Daryl was a graduate of the former Parker High School, and was an Honorable Discharged Veteran of the U.S. Army. Discharged with the rank of SP/3 (T), he earned the Good Conduct and National Defense Service Medals.
