WILLIAM LYNN "Bill" WULFERT, 82, of Parker passed away Saturday evening (05-31-14) at Sugarcreek Rest Home at Worthington following an illness. Born in Pittsburgh, Pa. on Dec. 22, 1931, he was the son of the late Lynn and Helene McGinnis Wulfert. He was married on June 30, 1956 to the former Mary Louise Terwilliger, and she survives. Bill was a graduate of the former Karns City High School. He was an honorably discharged veteran with the rank of Sergeant from the United States Air Force. Serving in the Korean War, his specialty was that of loadmaster. He was a longtime and faithful member of the VFW Post #7073 of Parker where he had served as commander and trustee. He also was a member of American Legion Post #598 at Parker. Bill was employed nearly forty-five years with Koppers (now Indespec) at Petrolia as a pipe fitter. In addition to his wife, he is survived by four children: Karen (Robert) York of White Post, VA., Randy, Mike, and Rick Wulfert, all of Parker; six grandchildren: Karen, Aaron, and Sunee Wulfert, Chris, Becca, and Daniel York; one sister: Barb (Ralph) McMillan of Ohio, and a number of nieces and nephews. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a sister, Mary Lou Wulfert. There will be a private visitation for family only. A public graveside service will be held at 11:00 AM Saturday, June 7th, at Parker Presbyterian Cemetery.
